Lorna continues to battle with England Squash to resolve the various issues with your ES Registrations – remember, it's up to you to 'activate' your membership by logging on to the England Squash website.

As the inescapable growth of the cashless society continues and the supply of "cash" dwindle, Laura has arranged for the procurement and installation of a "Sumup" card reader. This will enable everyone to pay for refreshments, match fees, guest fees, subscriptions etc without the need to remember to bring cash to the Club.

It is the intention that the Card Reader will replace the green bar tab book, in the first instance in the interests of members to remove the ability to inadvertently run up a large debit balance and secondly to provide greater security and anonymity for members.

Members are invited to clear their pages in the Green book in order that the Card Reader will operate solely from the New Year.

The card reader is now fully operational and can be found on top of the guest box. A set of instructions can be found on the side of the guest box should members be unsure how to use it. Please ensure that you input a clear reference [name and what you are purchasing] in the description box on the device when making a payment – it is a touch screen device!

Invoices will be sent to assist members in clearing their account in the new year.

However, for your convenience and as access to the Store for grips and balls is not always available, after considerable huffing and puffing and trials and tribulations, the Treasurer and Keith Wilson have masterminded the installation of a vending machine for a wide range of goods from balls and grips to crisps, chocolate, cereal bars, peanuts etc.

Unfortunately, the machine is cash operated by coins of the realm up to £1 and does give change.
