Dear Committee Member,

It was **AGREED** at the last Committee Meeting that a draft paper should be prepared to enable proper discussion to take place and a plan prepared to manage the Christopher Flint bequest.

First of all, two important matters were **AGREED** unanimously by the Committee:-

1. That Junior Club should be rebranded as “**CHRIS FLINT JUNIOR SQUASH**” and
2. That the Club would organise, host and manage an Annual Championships for Juniors entitled the “**CHRIS FLINT OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS**”

The following guidelines or fund management details need resolving or adopting.

- ✚ Traditional and/or historical ‘ordinary’ funding for Juniors should continue.
- ✚ The Fund is PRIMARILY intended for the Development of Junior Squash generally.
- ✚ Juniors showing “Exceptional” promise may qualify for a Coaching award from the Fund.
- ✚ The fund should be set up as a separate account and not the Club current account.
- ✚ **OR** The fund should be added to the Club’s existing savings account and an appropriate spread sheet maintained showing withdrawals or disbursements from the fund.
- ✚ The fund should be managed by a small group, possibly Annette, Laura Mather, Lee Picken, Gary Nolan and GSJ as Secretary to the group.
- ✚ ALL Coaches should be requested to present costed proposals to the Executive Committee.
- ✚ **OR** the requests may be delegated to the Group who would report back to the Executive.
- ✚ Proposals may include arrangements for group travelling and participation in out of County training sessions and competitions.
- ✚ Proposals may also include the “engagement “and visits to the Club by Level 4 and above inspirational Coaches.
- ✚ The Fund may be called upon to contribute to or underwrite the costs of awards and or prizes in the CHRIS FLINT OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS.
